The map collection includes all maps in Special Collections that are not included in the Louisiana Collection. All Louisiana/Mississippi River Maps are cataloged in the map drawers in the Reading Room and are located in cabinets 1-5. They have a separate finding aid. All other maps are located in cabinet 6, which is against the back wall when entering from the Reading Room.
